

Office of Study Abroad (OSA) scholarships are awarded on the basis of academic merit, financial need, and your personal statement. Students must have submitted a complete application to a study abroad program through OSA by the scholarship deadline to be considered for awards. Students on Student Initiated Programs (SIPs) must have applied to the host institution and must have completed the OSA SIP application. Applicants must be degree-seeking undergraduate or graduate students at KU with the following GPA requirements:

Semester/Academic Year Scholarships:

Undergraduates: minimum 3.0 cumulative in KU coursework
Graduates: minimum 3.5 cumulative in KU coursework

Summer, Winter Break and Spring Break Scholarships:

Undergraduates: minimum 3.25 cumulative in KU coursework
Graduates: minimum 3.5 cumulative in KU coursework

Scholarship Amounts and Deadlines*

Term of Study	Scholarship amounts	Deadline	Notification
Summer	\$250 to \$500	March 1	mid-April
Academic Year	\$750 to \$1500	March 1	early May
Fall Semester	\$500 to \$1000	March 1	early May
Spring Semester	\$500 to \$1000	October 1	early November
Winter Break or Spring Break	\$150	October 1	early November

****OSA Scholarship and Program Applications must be received by the deadline (March 1/October 1) to be considered for scholarships.***

Application Procedures

- Complete and submit study abroad program application to OSA.
- Complete the form on the back of this sheet.
- Attach one copy of your ARTS form
- Attach your Personal Statement
 - Include a typed, double-spaced essay no longer than 2 pages. Make sure your name is on the upper right hand corner of the page. The essay must address the following topics as specifically as possible:
 - 1) The reasons why you have chosen to study abroad.
 - 2) The specific academic rationale for the program you have chosen.
 - 3) The anticipated benefit of study abroad for your post graduate career and long term goals.
 - 4) The anticipated benefit of study abroad for your personal growth.
 - 5) Your current financial situation (e.g. Financial aid amounts, loans, scholarships, or other assistance). Indicate any special circumstances that may affect your financial ability to study abroad.
